Missions

- _____ YWCA Family Center (formerly the Interfaith Hospitality Network) – prepare and serve meals at the Family Center. TUMC does this once or twice a month. Good for individuals (adults and teens), groups and families with older children or teens.
- _____ Pizza-Making for Friends of the Homeless—Pizza making and delivery to this men’s shelter. TUMC does this monthly. Good for individuals and groups.
- _____ Habitat for Humanity. TUMC participates *Thursdays and Saturdays* from Spring through the Fall. Servants must be 16 or older.
- _____ NNEMAP (Near Northside Emergency Material Assistance Program). Besides donating, servants are needed to stock shelves and assist shoppers.
- _____ Amistad (Friendship)— Help with hosting quarterly events and providing snacks to this Hispanic/Latino Christian outreach ministry. This is good for all ages and families.
- _____ Bethlehem on Broad Street - Advent/Christmas Season Servants needed beginning *the second week of December* to pack, deliver and distribute hundreds of food baskets. Servants are also needed to help implement this major project.
- _____ Easter on Fifth Avenue – Servants are needed to help organize the purchasing of bedding for homeless neighbors and host a pot-luck lunch following worship on Good Friday.
- _____ Marsha Donner Mother’s Day Brunch—Servants are needed to help make corsages, set-up, serve and clean-up at this annual brunch put on by the Columbus Coalition for the Homeless.
- _____ Cuisine for a Cause – Annual fall dinner and silent auction to raise money for Trinity Missions.
